This privacy statement describes how we, SC “Lion Heart” NGO, will collect and use your personal data.

Personal Data

According to the GDPR, personal data is defined as:

"any information related to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); an identifiable natural person is a person who can be identified directly or indirectly, in particular by specifying an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or one or more factors specific to the physical, the physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person".

1. Who are we?

Why should "Lion Heart" collect and store personal data?

In any case, we are committed to ensuring that the information we collect and use is appropriate for this purpose and does not constitute an invasion of your privacy.

In order to contact you for direct marketing purposes, “Lion Heart” will contact you to ask for your prior consent.

- Provision of equipment for the competition

- Prevention of cheating and foul play during the competition;
- Ensuring the safety of competitors and spectators;
- Promotion of the competition and the activity of SC "Lion Heart" NGO

3.2 Processing based on consent:

In the cases where the processing of your personal data is not necessary, in view of fulfilling a contract, a legal provision, the legitimate interest of the administrator or a third party, as well as on other grounds, SC "Lion Heart" NGO will process your personal data only on the basis of your consent. By giving your consent, you allow us to process your personal data for precisely defined purposes. In order for SC "Lion Heart" NGO to process special categories of personal data, the subject's consent is required, and it must be explicitly given. When we ask you to provide us with sensitive personal data, we will always tell you why and how the data will be used.

You can withdraw your consent at any time by writing to the Data Protection Officer, whose contact you will find below.

4. Period of storage

SC “Lion Heart” NGO stores your data as follows:

Data, identifying the participants	Until the end of the competition for which they are provided and further on, if you agree to keep them for a subsequent competition. Consent may be withdrawn at any time in accordance with the terms of this statement.
Data for personal or emergency contact	

Data for the size of t-shirt	Unlimited in time as long as an archive of the races is kept. Any competitor may request to be removed from the rankings.
Data of participants regarding ranking	
E-mail address	As long as you do not object to our use of it

3.5. Your rights as a data subject:

At any time while we hold or process your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- Right of access - you have the right to request a copy of the data we store about you;
- Right to rectification - you have the right to correct inaccurate or incomplete data about you that we store.
- Right to be forgotten - in certain circumstances you can request that the data we hold about you be deleted from our records.
- Right to restriction of processing - where certain conditions are met, you have the right to restrict data processing.

- Right to portability - You have the right to have the data we store about you transferred to another person.
- Right to object - You have the right to object to certain types of processing of your data, such as direct marketing.
- Right to object to automated processing, including profiling – you also have all the rights that accrue to you in the event that you are subject to the legal consequences of automated processing or profiling.
- Right to legal redress: in the event that SC “Lion Heart” NGO refuses your request, in accordance with our access rights, we will state the reason for this. You have the right to lodge a complaint as set out in clause 3.6 below.

If there is a third party (as specified in point 3.3 above) in the processing of your personal data, all the above requests will be forwarded to it.

6. Appeals:

In the event that you wish to complain about the processing of your personal data by SC “Lion Heart” NGO (or third parties as described in clause 3.4 above) or to file a complaint about how your complaint has been dealt with, you have the right to complaint directly to the supervisory authority, as well as to the Data Protection Officer of SC “Lion Heart” NGO.

5. Additional information:

Under what circumstances will SC “Lion Heart” NGO be able to search for me?

We make every effort not to ask for unnecessary data. The information you provide will be subject to strict measures and procedures to minimize the risk of unauthorized access or disclosure of the data.

Can I find out what personal data SC “Lion Heart” NGO has of me?

At your request, SC "Lion Heart" NGO can confirm what information it stores about you and how it is processed. If SC "Lion Heart" NGO stores your personal data, you can request the following information:

- Identity and contact details of the person or organization that has determined how and why your data is processed. In some cases this will be their representative in the EU.
- Contact details of the Data Protection Officer, if any;
- The purpose and legal basis for processing your data;
- Information about the legitimate interests of SC "Lion Heart" NGO or of a third party, if the processing is carried out on such a basis.

- Recipient(s) or categories of recipients to whom the data is / will be disclosed.
- Information about how we ensure that, if we intend to transfer your personal data to persons in a third country or an international organization, it is transferred and stored securely.
